The twenty-year contract for the management of urban and equivalent waste between the Central Tuscany Authority and Alia SpA has been signed.
This activates the investment plan funded by the bond issue.

Florence, 1 September 2017 – The twenty-year contract for the management of urban and equivalent waste, including related services, in the 59 municipalities of the Metropolitan City of Florence and the Provinces of Pistoia and Prato, was signed yesterday by the Director of the Central Tuscany Authority, Sauro Mannucci, and Alia SpA CEO Livio Giannotti.

Alia SpA will therefore be able to activate the investment plan envisaged by the Contract, to be funded by means of the bond issue of 50 MM€, listed on the regulated markets, signed by institutional investors last March.
